

Hinton Recipes – Courgette Feta and Mint Soup

- 2 tbs. olive oil
- 4-6 courgettes, cut into large chunks
- 1 onion, sliced
- large clove garlic, crushed
- 600ml.vegetable stock
- 75g feta cheese
- 1 tbs. fresh mint, finely chopped
- 50ml.double cream



Heat the oil in a saucepan, add courgettes and onion; cook over a medium heat for 15 mins. until soft and lightly browned.

Add garlic and cook further 5 mins.

Add stock, simmer for 5 mins. Add feta cheese and mint; stir over low heat until feta has almost melted.

Blend until smooth

Reheat gently, adding cream before serving. Garnish with extra feta and mint if desired.
